Your board is considering moving forward with a plan to reduce toxic algae blooms and improve water clarity as early as spring of 2016. This will be a substantial investment. A similar plan has been followed by Long Lake for the last 15 years. This gives us confidence in the viability of our plan. We look forward to similar success for Black Lake.
