Business and Residential Notice of Herbicide Treatment • **Distribution Date:** 07/2/2019

In Treatment Area

In ¼ Mile Notification Area

Black Lake will be treated with aquatic herbicide **on or between July 18 – August 2** and a follow up treatment **on or between August 12 – September 14**, if required. Treatment(s) will not take place on weekends or holidays.

Product(s) planned for use/Active ingredient(s): Diquat Dibromide, Aquathol, Glyphosphate

Plants/Algae targeted: Nuisance levels of White Water Lily, Spatterdock Lily (Yellow Water Lily), Common Waterweed, Water Nymph, Coontail and Pondweed species. All of these plant species can reach densities in Black Lakes' high use areas creating barriers to recreational uses. The goal is to prevent high density conditions from developing and threatening the safety of lake users.

Location of treatment(s): Developed near shore and high use areas in Black Lake with nuisance levels.

The applicator will post signs in the treated and potentially affected areas no more than 48 hours prior to treatment. The signs will describe any water use restrictions or advisories.

If you are withdrawing water for potable or domestic water use, livestock watering, or irrigation, and have no alternate water source, please contact AquaTechnex at 360-330-0152 to arrange an alternate water supply.
