5. Old Business
 - a. Aquatic Insight provided a briefing on activities thus far for the IVAMP. The project needs a web link from the BLSD home screen for project updates. Project updates can be housed on the BLSD site or another managed by Aquatic Insight.
 - b. IAVMP Update
 - i. In person meeting(s) with the community and Aquatic Insight will be needed. The meeting location will likely be the Black Lake Bible Camp. Cory Freeborn has contacts with the Camp and can facilitate setup.
 - ii. Aquatic Insight will provide the slides from tonight’s presentation to the BLSD. The slides should be loaded to the BLSD web site for community access.
 - iii. *Cory will work with Linda (contact from Aquatic Insight) on setting up a website for the IAVMP process. This website will be separated from the BLSD website. A hyperlink from this new website will link to the BLSD website, and vice-versa.*



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- iv. Zoe (Aquatic Insight) will work with Cory to create a post-card flyer, with QR codes, to link to the new website for an introduction to the IAVMP process and a questionnaire. Hopefully we can have some of these postcards printed for the Columbus Park event.
 - v. Aquatic Insight is developing an outline of the IAVMP process for the Wa St DOE. This doesn't affect the work, nor is needed for any permits. It is put together to assist with grant applications later on and to keep DOE in the loop.
 - vi. An IAVMP public workshop is tentatively set for the week of June 13th. Two-hours are needed for the required meeting, with a ½ at each end for setup and takedown.
